  - a. Include at least one image or screenshot taken from the prototype illustrating the problem.
3. Iterate on the prototype and create a new prototype that has all the media and screen necessary to test if the user can learn the material and pass the quiz.
4. Test the revised prototype on two people. You may make updates after the second user.
5. Write down 5 of the biggest lessons you had from running it on users.
  - a. Include at least one image or screenshot taken from the prototype illustrating the problem.
